Ovarian malignancies constituted 15.11% of all gynecologic malignancies reported, with a median age of 45 years (range 4 to 93 years). A significant percentage of ovarian tumors (57.14%) presented in stage I. Epithelial ovarian cancers presented most commonly in stage 3. Non-epithelial neoplasms presented most commonly in stage 1.
