How to Identify an LS Engine

Chevrolet began utilizing the LS1 engine in the Corvette when they introduced the C5 in 1997. When first introduced, the LS1 was rated at 345 horsepower (257W) at 5,600 rpm and 350 lb./ft. of torque (475 Nm) at 4,400 rpm. The same powerplant was utilized (virtually unchanged) thru 2000.
