It has been cited as one of the seminal works of fiction of the 20th century and is studied in colleges and universities across the Western world. Gregor Samsa, a traveling salesman, wakes up in his bed to find himself transformed into a large insect. He attempts to roll over, only to discover that he cannot due to his new body—he is stuck on his hard, convex back. He tries to scratch an itch on his stomach, but when he touches himself with one of his many new legs, he is disgusted. He turns to the clock and sees that he has overslept and missed his train to work.

The Burrow is an incomplete narrative by Franz Kafka, written 1923-1924, and published posthumously in the magazine *Witiko* in 1931 by Max Brod. It tells of an animal's futile struggle to perfect the defence of his giant burrow against enemies. The narrative deals with becoming entangled in obsessive observation of a self-created labyrinth-like construct that causes heightened paranoia.
