In theory, social skills therapy will provide people on the autism spectrum with the ability to converse, share, play, and work with typical peers. The Importance of Social Skills Therapy for Autism

Effective Social Skills groups should*: Provide structure and predictability. Break down abstract social concepts into concrete actions. Simplify language and group children by language level. Work in pairs or groups with cooperation and partnership encouraged. Provide multiple and varied learning opportunities.

Social Skills Training consists of early-intervention behavioral treatments designed to foster “ correct ” behavioral development. The crux of this idea is to introduce a reward system (reward-motivated behavior) to teach children with ASD about the recognition and application of normal social skills.
